It's time for our annual production! Please read all instructions carefully to ensure that the correct costume is ordered for your dancer. It's extremely important to predict the correct size for your dancer. Here are some tips:

- ✿ When in doubt, always order the bigger size. It's easier to make costumes smaller than bigger!
- ✿ In June, costumes will be handed out in class by your instructor so we can ensure they fit properly. If it doesn't fit because you ordered the wrong size, there is a \$30 exchange fee required by the manufacturer and there's a good possibility that a new costume will not arrive by performance day!
- ✿ Costume companies will not accept returns or cancellations for any reason other than a manufacturer's defect. We will do everything we can to accommodate you; however, we cannot accept returns/cancellations due to the manufacturer's restrictions (even if dancer quits dancing).
- ✿ All production and costume fees will be automatically charged to your debit/credit card on file on February 15. This completed form must be returned to the front office by February 15 so that we may order the correct costumes sizes for you. Forms received after the 15th will be assessed a late order charge of \$30 per costume.
- ✿ *If your child will not be participating in this wonderful opportunity, please e-mail Office@TrinityArtsDance.net by February 15 so your debit/credit card will not be charged. Please list all classes that your dancer will NOT be performing in.*

- Picture Day will be held at Trinity Arts Dance Academy on Friday, June 20. Schedule will be posted on www.TrinityArtsDance.net closer to the event date. Be sure to check the website often for updates.
- For security purposes, general access during ALL rehearsals & performances **will be CLOSED**. Only authorized staff of the production may enter. This show cannot be done without parent volunteers to help out as ushers, stagehands, Class Moms, and more! If you are interested in volunteering as a production staff member, please fill out the information below. A staff member will contact you at a later date for further details.

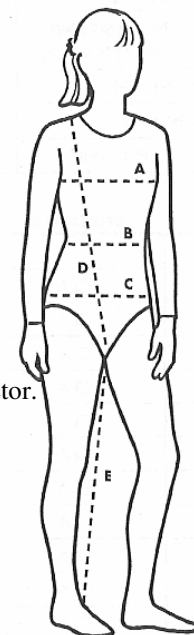

Now onto the ordering part...please turn over!

- ◆ Now onto the measuring! First measure your dancer for the measurements below. Be sure to have your dancer wearing a leotard, swimsuit or undergarments when taking measurements, not street clothes.

- A) Bust (with arms relaxed down at sides, measure the fullest part of bust): _____ inches
- B) Waist (measure around belly button, the narrowest part of the upper body): _____ inches
- C) Hips (measure around fullest part of the buttocks): _____ inches
- D) Girth (measure from the center of one shoulder, down the front through crotch and up the back to starting point; allow for curves of bust and abdomen): _____ inches
- E) Inseam (measure inside of leg, from crotch to bottom of ankle): _____ inches



- ◆ Next, find your measurements on the size chart below to find the appropriate size. When bust and hip measurements don't correspond with a particular size, the girth measurement should be used as a deciding factor.
